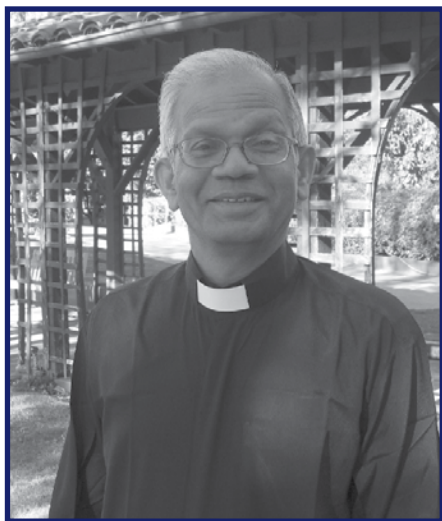


Wise Men from (and by way of) the East

We are glad to be welcoming additional Jesuits to the ministry of the Jesuit Retreat Center in 2007. Fr. Showraiah Dasari, S.J., of the Andhra Province in India, will be sharing the ministry here from January through July. Fr. Kevin Ballard, S.J., of the California Province, will join our Pastoral Staff just after Easter.

Originally from Andhra Pradesh, South India, Fr. Showraiah has been a Jesuit for over 38 years. Born in 1948, he has four brothers and three sisters. His father and most of his siblings live in India, where he was ordained in 1981 as the first priestly vocation from his century-old parish.

Fr. Showraiah has spent most of his Jesuit life in universities, serving in both academic and administrative positions.

He holds several degrees in the fields of education and political science, including a Ph.D. in the latter. His administrative skills led to his appointment as both President and Rector of Andhra Loyola College in India. In his Jesuit province he has served in formation,

as a Province Consultor, and as representative of his province at international Jesuit meetings.

One of the most memorable experiences that has given shape to his ministry was his meeting with Blessed Mother Teresa in Calcutta. Father Showraiah speaks fondly of how she influenced his approach to service and to life in general. Her witness motivated, for example, his ministry to the poor during his philosophical and theological studies.

After many years of distinguished leadership in education, Fr. Showraiah left university life at age 58

(the required retirement age in India) and applied to his Jesuit Provincial for a sabbatical. This led him to the Jesuit School of Theology, Berkeley, where he completed a six-month program of courses in Ignatian spirituality, prayer and meditation, and pastoral counseling.

Fr. Showraiah chose to spend this second phase of his sabbatical at the Jesuit Retreat Center and is very much looking forward to sharing in our retreat ministry. "I am very excited to be here. The peaceful atmosphere of the Retreat Center makes me feel so much at home. The hills and trees add to the serenity of the place, which is tucked away from the hustle and bustle of downtown Los Altos." He has led such an active life for the past 38 years that he is looking forward to a more contemplative way of life, using his education, skills, and experience in a new and vital ministry.

Fr. Showraiah has already begun sitting in on weekend retreats here to familiarize himself with the flow of life and the retreat traditions of the JRC. He will be assisting the Jesuit Pastoral Staff with spiritual direction, Masses, individually-directed retreats, and preached weekend retreats.

The other new face, one familiar to many, is that of Fr. Kevin Ballard, S.J., who will be joining the Pastoral Staff in April. (The summer edition of JRC News will feature a longer article on him.) Fr. Kevin, a San Franciscan who was ordained in 1985, was on the JRC staff from 1988 to 1992, preaching many retreats both on the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius and for the 12-Step Recovery community. His assignments since have included Pastor of Holy Trinity Parish, San Jose, and Associate Pastor at St. Agnes Parish, San Francisco.

Fr. Kevin cultivates an interest in world religions, cultures, and languages. He speaks a number of languages in addition to English, including Spanish, Tagalog, Vietnamese, and Nepalese. He has traveled widely in Nepal, where he taught and served as chaplain for Mother Teresa's sisters from 1992 to 1993 and from 1996 to 1999, and in India, where he gave retreats for sisters. "It is good to come back," Fr. Kevin said. "My real passion is giving weekend retreats."

To The Other Towns

The Vatican has recently announced the appointment of two Northern California auxiliary bishops to their own episcopal sees, Bishop Richard Garcia to the Diocese of Monterey and Bishop John Wester to the Diocese of Salt Lake City.

Bishop Garcia was born in San Francisco and ordained for the Archdiocese. With the creation of the Diocese of San Jose, he found himself in the new diocese, where he worked in a variety of ministries, including to Hispanic Catholics. Ordained a bishop in 1998, he has since served as auxiliary to Bishop William Weigand in Sacramento. For the last few years, Bishop Garcia has organized the bishops' annual retreat here at the Jesuit Retreat Center, and it has been a pleasure and grace for us to work with him. He will be installed in Monterey on January 30, 2007.

Bishop Wester, also born in San Francisco, was ordained for the Archdiocese in 1976. He served the Archdiocese in parishes, campus ministry, and administration before being ordained a bishop in 1998. He has since served as auxiliary in San Francisco, with the role of Vicar General among his tasks, and as Apostolic Administrator of the Archdiocese from August of 2005 to February of 2006. Also a good friend of the Jesuit community here at the Retreat Center, Bishop Wester will be installed in Salt Lake City on March 14, 2007.

St. Joseph's Corner

We're glad to have Leo Mitrovich, Chief Plant Engineer, back with us, well recovered after surgery in September. It's good to have the crew complete again, as we never have a shortage of repairs and projects. Their "ministry of maintenance" plays an important role in supporting the programs of the Retreat Center and providing for the comfort and safety of our guests.

Many of our retreatants have noted that the Registration Office now has a welcoming new look. A soffit outlines the route of the new water mains, new key cabinets and a new desk facilitate check-in, and the gentle green walls lend an inviting calm. (Please see the photo on page 5.) The generosity of Mr. William Baumel supported this project in honor of Fr. Jim Hanley, S.J.

The crew is now busy in St. Francis Hall. A breaker box and modern wiring is supplanting our last fuse box and sections of historic knob and tube wiring, and copper pipe is replacing decaying galvanized throughout. The plumbing project will include conversion of one bathroom to meet ADA standards. Safety and accessibility continue to be priorities in our planning.

Invoking the Spirit

These are exciting days here in the United States Assistancy of the Jesuits, as throughout the Society of Jesus.

In all the provinces of the Society, official gatherings called Province Congregations have just taken place, beginning preparation for a General Congregation in Rome at the start of 2008. This meeting of Jesuit representatives from all over the globe will elect a new Superior General to replace Fr. Peter-Hans Kolvenbach, who has asked for and received the Pope's permission to resign after more than 25 years of service. The General Congregation will also reflect on and legislate for the Society as we move together into a new phase of our history.

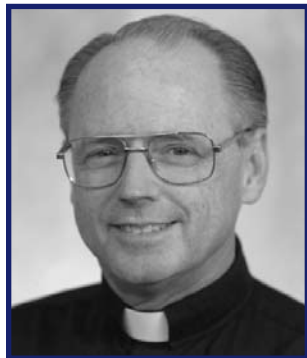
Meanwhile, the United States Assistancy is preparing for a reconfiguration of boundaries and resources so that we can better serve the needs of the Church in the years ahead. Our provincials have taken the lead in a Strategic Discernment process, involving in the conversation countless Jesuit and lay colleagues in ministry. We will keep you posted as the details of our new look are decided and all through the decade of its implementation.

The Province Congregation, which met here in late December, included, for the first time, lay colleagues involved in each of the ministries of the Province. They took part in the activities of the first day, which included a State of the Province address by Fr. John McGarry, S.J. The participants engaged in a creative dialogue about the Society and the Province, present and future. Frs. Paul Locatelli and Mike Kennedy were elected to join the Provincial in representing us in Rome next winter.

Please keep the Society of Jesus in your prayers as we continue to prepare together for the General Congregation, both that we might be open to the Spirit in the preparations and in the days of the Congregation and that the Spirit might bless with wisdom those who gather. Remember, too, the Assistancy as we continue the process of Strategic Discernment, asking that the Spirit bless us with openness and wisdom, with trust and hope.

Sharing the Good News

Captains have been a mainstay of the Retreat Center from the start, their efforts in promoting retreats integral, leading many to make a first retreat and to commit to a yearly retreat. Their enthusiasm and dedication continue to bless us today and to assist the Spirit's work.

I was grateful that many Captains accepted my invitation to an afternoon of reflection and conversation, Eucharist and companionship on Sunday, November 19. Six women and 29 men reflected, in prayer and in groups, on what they see as 1) the main benefits of JRC retreats, 2) their own successes and challenges in promoting retreats, 3) ways that the JRC might more effectively share the Gospel message, and 4) new communities we might serve and how we might best reach them.

The Captains were grateful for the renewal they find in our peaceful setting, in prayer shared with peers (even in silence!), in comforting devotions and liturgy, and in encouraging, and sometimes challenging, presentations. They noted that retreats provide tools useful in their daily lives, notably a stronger grounding in faith.

Each group's report emphasized the effectiveness of personal connection, including with supportive pastors. The Captain's personal witness, they noted, is most persuasive. They mentioned the difficulty of convincing today's busy people that a retreat is worth the commitment of their time and money and the challenge of allaying the fears of some at the prospect of solitude and vulnerability.

The Captains encouraged retreats that are practical and down-to-earth, use of humor as a vehicle for getting points across, and expanded use of media to complement the talks and exercises. They noted the importance of our published retreat-promotion materials, of collaboration with pastors, others on parish staffs, and groups within parishes, and of creative use of our website and e-mail.

The group's responses supported the broadening of outreach to young and old, married and single, women and men, and, of course, a wide range of ethnic and language groups that has been underway for a number of years. The strategies they mentioned as important include many we already employ and one particularly promising: recruiting in each parish a team of Captains, of varying ages and including young adults.

The Captains shared other recommendations, and I will be working in the coming months with the staff and with Captains, veteran and new, so that the wisdom of the Captains will continue to leaven our ministry.

Dear Retreatants and Friends,

2006 has been a year filled with God's blessings for the Retreat Center.

Weekend and weekday retreats alike have continued to draw a widening spectrum of people seeking to know God more deeply and to live their Christian discipleship in greater creativity and fidelity. We have been able to host a second retreat for homeless men and a first for homeboys, helping the participants in both to imagine and to choose good futures for themselves. We have begun the Pierre Favre Program in direction of the Spiritual Exercises, preparing lay people and Jesuits together to meet the growing demand for personal accompaniment through that fundamental Ignatian experience.

Fr. Bernie Bush, S.J., and Leo Mitrovich, Chief Plant Engineer, both regained good health and returned to work after accidents and surgeries. The Province sent Fr. Jerry Hudson to join our retreat team in August, in good time to celebrate his sixtieth birthday with us in December. (Of course, we lost Fr. Peter Filice to Loyola High, where they are blessed to have him as superior of the Jesuit community.) We were able to replace the entire water main system on the property, addressing a source of

repeated and very costly flooding, and to complete many other buildings and grounds projects.

I am ever more aware that the support of our benefactors has been essential to the development of the ministry here, has sustained it and allowed it to grow since 1925, and will continue to enable it to flourish into the future. A special grace for me is the enthusiasm of many of our benefactors for extending the opportunity to share in retreat experiences to others. Many who might otherwise not have access to the blessings of retreat do have such access because of your generosity.

Again, I thank you, our benefactors, on behalf of the Jesuit Retreat Center staff and on behalf of our many retreatants who benefit from your kindness. I thank, as well, our Retreat Captains and our team of volunteers for their essential assistance in many phases of our ministry. You are all remembered and cherished here in prayer, particularly in each Wednesday afternoon Mass in Rossi Chapel. All God's blessings!
